Their experiments soon developed into a full-scale side-project, with 8-year-old Nicholas helping perfect the scent and 10-year-old Catalina designing the packaging. The tiny family perfumerie now produces olive oil and shea butter soaps and eau de perfume sprays for 20 boutiques in its namesake borough and will add a home fragrance and body cream in the coming months—to help you feel at home no matter how far from it you travel.
